

SPEEDY CAMPING AND PARKING GOLF CART INFORMATION

GOLF CART AND UTV RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All golf carts and utvs must be registered and display a Speedy Camping and Parking Golf Cart Permit.
- Registration is available at both entrances.
- The registration application must be completed, and paid for by the owner with the golf cart/utv present.
- The \$35.00 permits are issued on an annual basis.
- Permits must be prominently displayed on left front of the golf cart/utv.
- Operators must have a valid drivers license.
- Excessive speed will not be tolerated - speed limit is 5 mph.
- Golf carts/utvs are not to be operated in a manner that endangers the passengers or others.
- No overloading of passengers - the number of seats equals the number of passengers allowed. All passengers must be seated.
- STATE LAW - Open alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any golf cart. No one under the influence of alcohol may operate a golf cart per Ohio Revised Code 4511.19.
- Golf carts/utvs operated after dark must have headlights or sufficient lighting.
- Golf carts/utvs are not permitted to operate during quiet times - 12 am to 7:00 am.
- Excessive driving/cruising the campground is not allowed. You will be asked to return to your campsite.
- All driveways are considered FIRE LANES.
- Designated parking area is located near the highway at both entrances when you want to enter into Eldora Speedway.
- Golf carts/utvs are prohibited from driving on, or crossing, any highway or road per state law. No driving on, or crossing of State Route 118 - this includes the shoulders and right-of-ways.
- Ohio Revised Code 4519.40 Prohibits golf carts from being on any public roadways at any time. Violators will be cited, fined and be subject to 3 days in jail.
- Golf carts/utvs will not be permitted to operate under extreme wet conditions. All carts will be shut down.
- Failure to comply with these rules and regulations may result in the golf cart/utv being impounded. The operator may also be evicted from Speedy Camping and Parking. There will be NO REFUNDS.
- Speedy Camping and Parking is not responsible for any accidents, injuries, or theft associated with the use of a golf cart/utv at Speedy Camping and Parking.

Ohio's drinking and driving law, Operating Vehicle Under the Influence - OVI (Ohio Revised Code 4511.19) and Open Container Laws (ORC4301.62) apply to all Vehicles, including Golf Carts, at all times within the entire State of Ohio and will be enforced.
